Kushite Kings on the Upper Nile

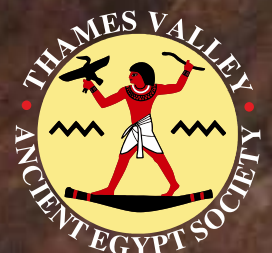

Recently fragments of several royal statues, including the Pharaoh Taharqo, have been uncovered within the 1st Century Amun temple at Dangeil, a Kushite site in Sudan which necessitate a substantial re-evaluation of the accepted history of the period. Altars, ram statues, colourful architectural fragments and the discovery of a contemporary pyramid field are helping to establish an image of the ancient sacred landscape.
