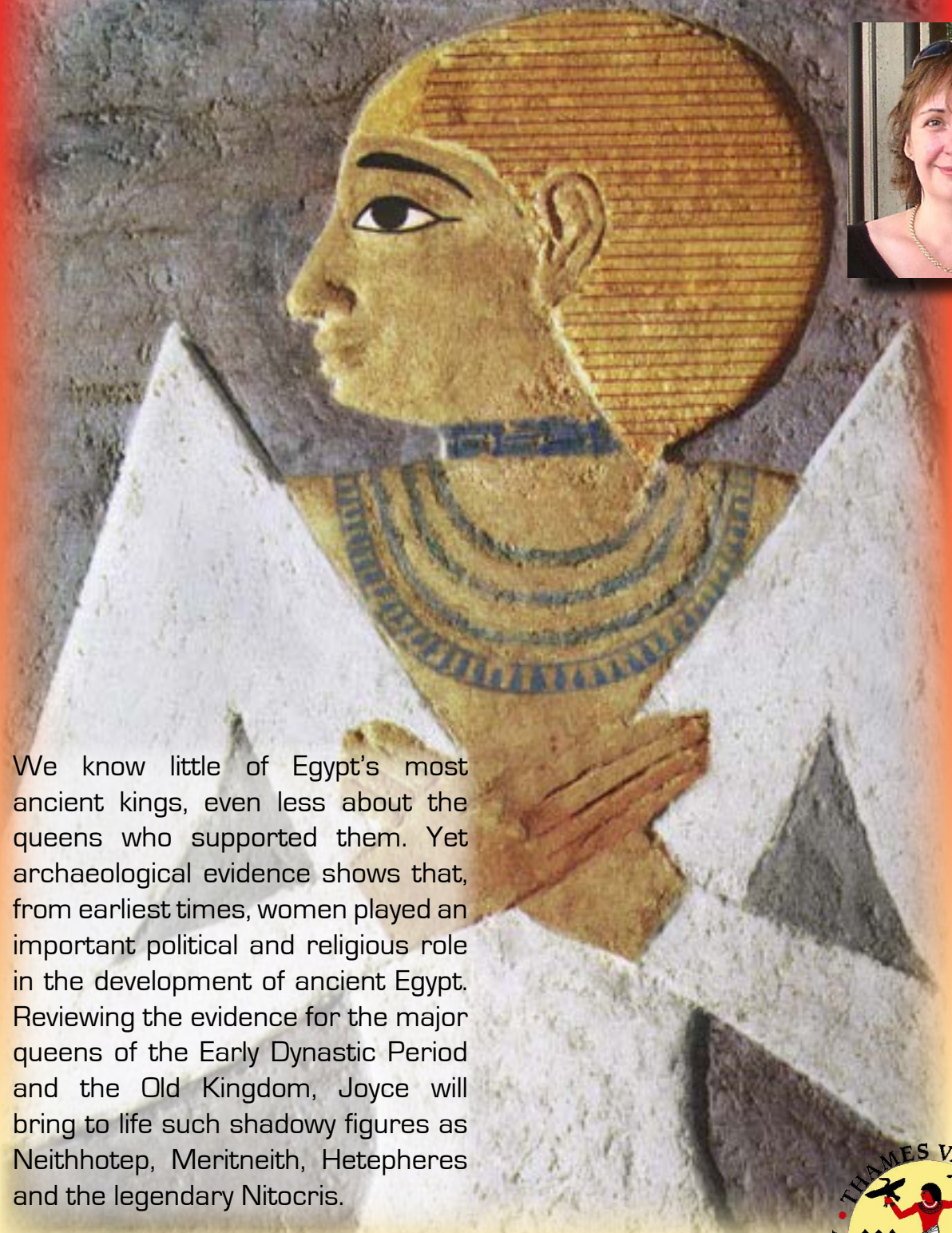


A Thames Valley Ancient Egypt Society Public Lecture
