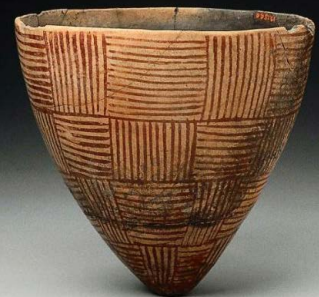

The Lower Nubian communities that were contemporary with Predynastic Egypt are primarily known from the rescue campaigns of the 20th century. Much of this work has remained unpublished but archives provide unique evidence for A-Group mortuary rituals and settlement patterns. These highlight the distinctive nature of A-Group culture and society, and can also provide new insights into the early relationships between Egypt and Nubia.
